Wainui Beach Ride

- An easy and picturesque ride of 6km from Gisborne City to world famous Wainui Surf Beach
- Enjoy a picnic on the beachfront
- Swim, bodysurf or sunbathe on a pristine white sand beach

Route Directions

- Begin from the Gisborne i-SITE Information Centre. You'll find plenty of free parking there for your campervan, and it's directly opposite the Skate & Cycle Park.
- Cycle up to the Gisborne Town Clock and turn right.
- Go through Gisborne's shopping centre and over the Gladstone Road Bridge.
- Continue out along State Highway 35 to Wainui Beach.
- Return the same way



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Gisborne City Scenic Ride

- A 4km ride, mostly flat but including a climb up historic Kaiti Hill, with fabulous views of Gisborne City, Young Nicks Head and the landing site of Captain Cook and crew – the first Europeans to set foot on New Zealand soil.

Route Directions

- Begin from the Gisborne i-SITE Information Centre. You'll find plenty of free parking there for your campervan, and it's directly opposite the Skate & Cycle Park.
- Cycle up to the Gisborne Town Clock and turn right.
- Go through Gisborne's shopping centre and over the Gladstone Road Bridge.
- Take the first turn to the right and cycle along the waterfront as far as Works Café.
- Turn left into Crawford, then left again into Parau and follow the road around to Ranfurly.
- Turn right into Queens Drive, and begin the hill climb to the Kaiti Hill Lookout.
- Return the same way.
